RECIPE OF THE MONTH

Zucchini Bread

Ingredients: 1 ½ cups sugar 1/3 cups brown sugar ¾ cups oil 2 eggs 2 cups flour ¾ tsp baking powder ¾ tsp baking soda ½ tsp salt 2 ½ tsp cinnamon 1 ½ cups shredded zucchini ¾ walnut pieces (optional)

Pre heat oven to 350, grease and flour 2 loaf pans, combine sugars, oil and eggs and mix.

In another bowl, mix flour, baking powder, soda, salt and cinnamon. Add to sugar/oil/egg mixture to moisten. Carefully fold in zucchini and nuts. Turn into pans, bake until done (about 55 minute). Let cool before turning out onto rack.




