

RECIPE OF THE MONTH

PUMPKIN BREAD

Makes three 7 x 3 inch loaves

INGREDIENTS:

- 1 (15 ounce) can pumpkin puree
- 4 eggs
- 1 cup vegetable oil
- 2/3 cup water
- 3 cups white sugar
- 3 1/2 cups all-purpose flour
- 2 teaspoons baking soda
- 1 1/2 teaspoon salt
- 1 teaspoon ground cinnamon
- 1 teaspoon ground nutmeg
- 1/2 teaspoon ground cloves 1/4 teaspoon ground ginger

DIRECTIONS:

- 1. Preheat oven to 350 degrees
- 2. Grease and flour three 7 x 3 inch loaf pans
- 3. In a large bowl, mix together pumpkin puree, eggs, oil, water and sugar until well blended
- 4. In a separate bowl, whisk together the flour, baking soda, salt, cinnamon, nutmeg, cloves and ginger.
- 5. Stir the dry ingredients into the pumpkin mixture until just blended. Pour into the prepared pans.
- 6. Bake for about 50 minutes in the preheated oven.
- 7. Loaves and done when toothpick inserted in the center comes out clean.




