



When he passed away in 2002, I honored him with the numbers on the side of my hood along with "MC" for Marine Corps. From there I was asked by the WWII veterans at the Dundalk American Legion to be a part of their 4th of July parade, carrying Vets in my Jeep. I agreed only if I could honor all branches of the service, not advertise anything or anyone and that any acknowledgement in honor of my dad, Billie Seay (since I did not serve in the military myself).

In the meantime, I am busy working on another project—restoring from the ground up a 1961 Jeep CJ6. I hope to be able to participate in car shows within the next couple of years. Lots of work still to do. More on that project another time.

RECIPE OF THE MONTH

Black Magic Cake

INGREDIENTS:

- 1 3/4 cups all purpose flour
- 2 cups white sugar
- 3/4 cup unsweetened cocoa powder
- 2 teaspoons baking soda
- 1 teaspoon baking powder
- 1 teaspoon salt
- 2 eggs
- 1 cup strong brewed coffee
 - 1 cup buttermilk
 - 1/2 cup vegetable oil
 - 1 teaspoon vanilla extract

DIRECTIONS:

- 1. Preheat oven 350 degrees
- 2. Grease and flour two 9 inch round cake pans OR one 9 X 13 pan
- 3. In a large bowl combine flour, sugar, cocoa, baking soda, baking powder and salt. Make a well in the center.
- 4. Add eggs, coffee, buttermilk, oil and vanilla. Beat for 2 minutes on medium speed. Batter will be thin.
- 5. Pour into prepared pan(s).
- 6. Bake 350 degrees for 30 to 40 minutes, or until toothpick inserted into center of cake comes out clean. Cool for 10 minutes.
- 7. Frost as desired.






