
There is even an area where fans can compete jacking up cars, changing tires and using the big gas can (empty of course)!

The Story Of This Willys

It all started when I was 12 years old and I was looking through a Hot Rod Magazine, there was a pair of Willys drag racing at a track in California. I decided that some day I would like to own a Willys. Well, 41 years later I was allowed to refinance our home (wife made it happen) to get a turn key 41 Willys that was at a car show in South Carolina. That car was totaled 5 years later and I quickly found out that the car I had was under insured. I searched online and found a lot of cars that were either way more money than I had or not nearly as good as I had. I was told about this car by some friends, the owner was retiring and moving to another state, so he wanted to sell his Willys project as well as his turn key coupe (I think it was a 32). I bought the project because only another Willys would do and I have a very talented brother, Bryan. We had to rewire the car, get a transmission and fuel system. The system that came with the car was awesome but issues dictated to go with a carburated engine and a nice lumpy cam. RECIPE OF THE MONTH

RED BEANS, RICE, AND SAUSAGE

Ingredients:

Rice- measured according to package directions, usually ¹/₄ cup per person Water- measured according to package directions for the rice, usually 1-1/2

times the amount of dry rice

1 Can of dark red kidney beans

1 Link of Andouille sausage

Cooking for one, I measure ¼ cup of rice into the rice cooker, and add maybe 1/3 cup of water (the liquid from the canned beans reduces the amount of water needed). I then add one can of red kidney beans, and cut up one link of Andouille sausage, all directly into the rice cooker. Put on the lid, plug it in, push the "start" button, and walk away. This rice cooker is automatic, and will shut itself off when ready. Your machine may work differently. So far, putting all the ingredients directly into the rice cooker doesn't seem to damage it.

I could add more rice based on the number of servings desired, without increasing the amount of beans or sausage, up to the capacity of the cooker. The single serving version above is a little heavy on the beans and sausage. Most restaurant servings have just enough beans and sausage to convince the customer they aren't being cheated.






