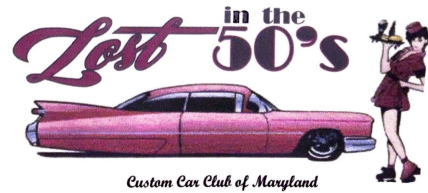

Macaroni Salad

1 cup Mayo
2 Tbsp Vinegar
1 Tbsp Prepared Mustard
1 Tsp Sugar
1 Tsp Salt
1/4 Tsp Pepper
8 oz Elbow Macaroni, cooked and drained
1/2 - 1 Cup Sliced Celery
1/4 Cup Chopped Onion
1/2 - 1 Cup Chopped Green or Red Pepper (optional)

Combine the first 6 ingredients.

Stir in remaining ingredients.

Cover....chill....eat....enjoy.
