RECIPE OF THE MONTH

Since the weather is starting to get warmer, here is a quick and light pasta for an easy meal.

Lemon Capellini By Ina Garten

2 teaspoons Kosher salt

1 teaspoon freshly ground black pepper

1 pound dried capellini (aka angel hair)

1/2 pound (2 sticks) unsalted butter

3 lemons; Zest and juice of 2 large lemons 1 for garnish

- 1. Add 2 tablespoons of salt to a large pot of boiling water. Add the capellini and cook for 3 to 4 minutes, until just al dente.
- 2. Meanwhile, heat a large (12-inch) sauté pan, add the butter, and heat until the butter is melted. Add the zest and juice of the 2 lemons. Add 2 teaspoons salt and 1 teaspoon pepper and swirl the pan to combine.
- 3. As soon as the pasta is cooked, lift the pasta out of the water with tongs, allowing most but not all of the water to drain back into the pot, and add all the pasta to the sauce. Cook for one minute, adding pasta water to the sauce with a ladle just enough to keep the pasta moist.
- 4. Transfer the pasta to a serving platter or individual plates. Garnish with more lemon zest, sprinkle with salt and pepper, and squeeze a little lemon juice on top.
 - Suggestions to dress the pasta up:
 - Serve with a portion of grilled chicken to make it a hearty meal.
 - Top with scallops, salmon or sauteed shrimp.
 - Saute garlic or shallots with the melted butter and lemon to add extra flavor.
 - Toss in roasted vegetables or turn it into a seasonal angel hair primavera.
