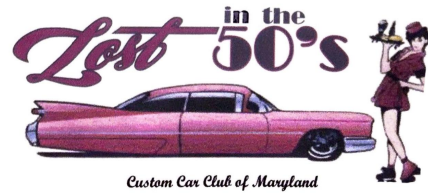

Cruisin' was commonplace in the 50's and 60's, usually held at the local drive-in restaurant or any parking lot available to hang out. Normally, Cruisin' would end up in a night of drag racing on the back roads. However, today we take them down to a sanctioned drag strip.

Original cars, custom rods, street machines, muscle cars, sports cars, kit cars- all other professionally built or built in the backyard are displayed at Cruisin'.

A lot of time and money goes into these cars. Therefore, we ask everyone to LOOK, but please DO NOT TOUCH! Lost in the 50's Custom Car Club has been able to acquire this Cruisin' lot to RE-LIVE part of the past and show off years of labor, talent, and love for the cars.

Here's an easy dump cake recipe from Taste of Home. This should be a tasty treat for any summer barbecue!!!

Easy Blueberry Dump Cake Recipe

Ingredients

1 can (21 ounces) blueberry pie filling
1/2 teaspoon almond extract
2 cups fresh or frozen blueberries
1/3 cup packed brown sugar
1 package (16-1/2 ounces) yellow cake mix
3/4 cup butter, melted
Whipped cream, optional

Directions

Preheat oven to 350

Mix pie filling and almond extract together in a bowl, and spread into a greased 11×7-in. baking dish.

Stir together blueberries and brown sugar and sprinkle over the pie filling.

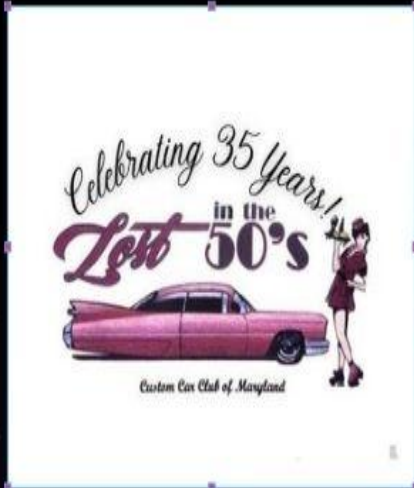
Next comes the cake mix: Sprinkle it evenly over the fruit and drizzle with butter.

Bake until golden brown, about 30-35 minutes. Cool the cake on a wire rack. If desired, serve dolloped with homemade whipped cream and additional fresh blueberries.

Driveshaft Center Support Bearing

If your vehicle has a two-piece driveshaft (found on many full size GM cars 1958-1976) check the center support bearing unit (AKA carrier bearing) to ensure it's in place and intact. Warning signs of problems are vibrations and clutch chatter on stick-shift vehicles. You may be able to do a quick visual from the rear using a bright light or remote inspection camera. If in doubt pull the driveshaft to inspect. Don't forget to lube the U joints. A1 Drive Shaft service in Locust Point, Baltimore is fast, reasonably priced, and does great work to include balancing. Their number is 410-752-3000.

Heads up on Trailer Hook ups

We recently met a gentleman at a show on Kent Island who had trailered his pristine '58 Corvette from Virginia. In helping him load-out, we discovered that his hitch ball was undersized, allowing the trailer to detach whenever the tongue lifted up. How he made the trip from Virginia to Kent Island was miraculous. Luckily he had the correct ball onboard and changed it out. Lessons learned: 1) If you tow, double check all connections 2) I highly recommend using a checklist and a helper. Also, if your trailer is equipped with emergency breakaway brakes, the activation cable needs to be attached to the the tow vehicle's frame - not the hitch.

Hi-Temp and Hi-Strength Wire Ties

If you need to mount an electric cooling fan or fluid cooler against your radiator, I recommend using high-temperature/high-strength wire ties. McMaster-Carr carries a wide assortment of lengths, widths, thicknesses, temperature ranges, and strengths. They also carry many other hard-to-find fasteners and commercial/industrial grade products suitable for automotive use. Their website is <https://www.mcmaster.com>.

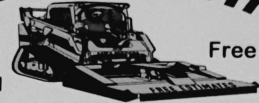
