10 34 oz can of cream of mushroom soup

1 cup shredded cheese

21 oz bag of frozen tator tots (or raw shredded potatoes)

# **Directions**

- 1. Crumble raw ground beef in bottom of slow cooker. Sprinkle with salt and pepper
- 2. Layer remaining ingredients on beef in order listed
- 3. Cover. Cook on High for 1 hour, then reduce to Low and cook another 3 hours. Enjoy




