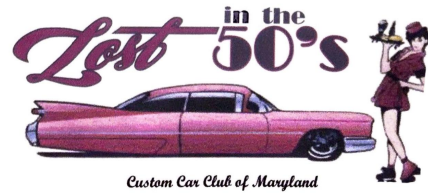

2023 was full of challenges for the Lost in the 50's Car Club. It was also a year of nice accomplishments.

Challenges:

- moving to a smaller lot (H) which was half the size of the previous lot (G)
- inability to have cruises open to all vehicles for our special fundraisers
- moving our equipment weekly from G lot to H lot
- sharing H lot with the fireworks display for 6 weeks
- 11 weeks where Mother Nature did not cooperate

Accomplishments:

While the smaller lot and the weather-related cancellations caused us to have less income - mainly for our fundraisers (Faces of Valor, Turkey Trot, Christmas in July), the generosity of the people who came to the lot allowed us to continue to make significant donations.

- Center of Applied Technology (CAT) North - we offer a generous scholarship to a LITF family member who attends CAT North. If we do not have anyone who fits that category, the scholarship is given to a deserving student.

- Faces of Valor (FOV) - this is one of our annual fundraiser events. We make a generous donation each year to FOV. Faces of Valor identifies a deserving person each year. Scholarships or financial aid are given for men and women in the military, fire, police and EMS services who have been injured or killed in the line of duty. Ted Levitt is the President and Founder of Faces of Valor and has been a member of Lost in the 50's since 2012.

RECIPE OF THE MONTH

Hoosier Sugar Cream Pie from State of Dinner Website

INSTRUCTIONS

Roll pie crust dough into an 11-inch circle. Place in a pie pan, pressing out any air pockets. Prick the bottom and sides of the pie crust with a fork. Line with parchment paper and fill the crust with pie weights or dried beans. Bake according to your pie crust recipe directions for a single-crust baked pie shell, then cool completely.

In a medium saucepan, whisk sugar and cornstarch together. Add cream and butter to the pan and cook over medium heat, whisking continually. Bring the mixture to a boil and then cook one minute longer. Whisk the custard continuously, using care to scrape the bottom of the pan regularly, so that the mixture does not burn.

Remove from heat and whisk in the vanilla extract and salt. Pour the cream mixture into the cooled pie crust and smooth using a spoon or spatula.

Pour the melted butter over the top of the pie. Combine 2 tablespoons of sugar with 1 teaspoon of ground cinnamon and sprinkle evenly over the top of the butter.

Place the pie on the top rack of your oven and broil for 1-2 minutes, until the sugar crystallizes and browns. Watch carefully so you don't burn your pie!

Remove from oven and cool to room temperature, then transfer to the refrigerator until ready to serve.

INGREDIENTS

1 pie crust
1/3 cup cornstarch
1 cup granulated sugar
5 tablespoon butter
3 cups heavy cream
1 tablespoon vanilla
1 pinch table salt
Topping
2 tablespoon melted butter
2 tablespoon granulated sugar
1 teaspoon cinnamon

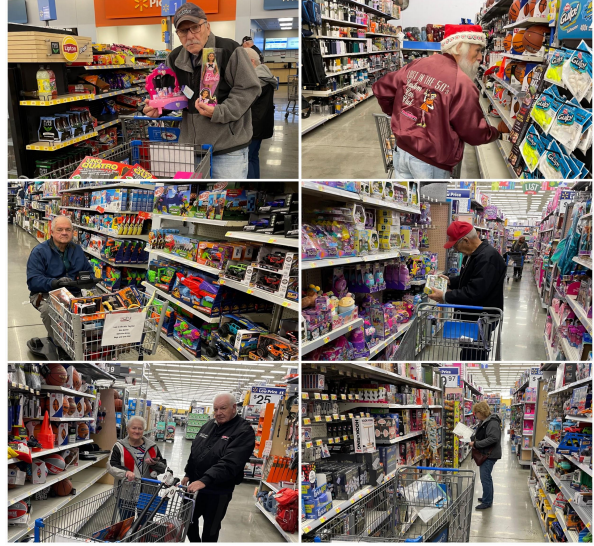



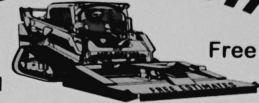
