**Challenges:**

Accomplishments:

### **RECIPE OF THE MONTH**

### Hoosier Sugar Cream Pie from State of Dinner Website

### **INSTRUCTIONS**

Roll pie crust dough into an 11-inch circle. Place in a pie pan, pressing out any air pockets. Prick the bottom and sides of the pie crust with a fork. Line with parchment paper and fill the crust with pie weights or dried beans. Bake according to your pie crust recipe directions for a single-crust baked pie shell, then cool completely.

In a medium saucepan, whisk sugar and cornstarch together. Add cream and butter to the pan and cook over medium heat, whisking continually. Bring the mixture to a boil and then cook one minute longer. Whisk the custard continuously, using care to scrape the bottom of the pan regularly, so that the mixture does not burn.

Remove from heat and whisk in the vanilla extract and salt. Pour the cream mixture into the cooled pie crust and smooth using a spoon or spatula. INGREDIENTS

1 pie crust ⅓ cup cornstarch 1 cup granulated sugar 5 tablespoon butter 3 cups heavy cream 1 tablespoon vanilla 1 pinch table salt Topping 2 tablespoon melted butter 2 tablespoon granulated sugar 1 teaspoon cinnamon

Pour the melted butter over the top of the pie. Combine 2 tablespoons of sugar with 1 teaspoon of ground cinnamon and sprinkle evenly over the top of the butter.

Place the pie on the top rack of your oven and broil for 1-2 minutes, until the sugar crystallizes and browns. Watch carefully so you don't burn your pie!

Remove from oven and cool to room temperature, then transfer to the refrigerator until ready to serve.






