# **RECIPE OF THE MONTH**

I found this recipe on Taste of Home website. It should be great for a weekend brunch, or last minute get togethers.

**Crustless Spinach Quiche Ingredients** 

1 cup chopped onion

1 cup sliced fresh mushrooms

1 tablespoon canola oil

1 package (10 ounces) frozen chopped spinach, thawed and well drained

2/3 cup finely chopped fully cooked ham

5 large eggs

3 cups shredded Muenster or Monterey Jack cheese

1/8 teaspoon pepper

## **Directions**

In a large skillet, saute onion and mushrooms in oil until tender. Add spinach and ham; cook and stir until the excess moisture is evaporated. Cool slightly.

Beat eggs; add cheese and mix well.

Stir in spinach mixture and pepper; blend well.

Spread evenly into a greased 9- in. pie plate or quiche dish.

Bake at 350° for 40-45 minutes or until a knife inserted in center comes out clean.

Some other suggestions instead of spinach and ham are:
Mediterranean: Instead of ham and Muenster or Monterey Jack
cheese, add olives, feta cheese and roasted red peppers to the filling.
Make it with bacon: Broccoli and cheddar cheese are a classic
combination and they combine beautifully with crispy bacon for a
tasty, satisfying crustless quiche. Be sure to chop your broccoli finely
for the perfect quiche texture.

Use sausage and Swiss: Given that sausage and kale pair so nicely together, it only makes sense that they would also make for a yummy crustless quiche variation. Swiss cheese adds a nice nuttiness to the quiche.


